Why?	This activity aims at <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - exchanging about their experience - describing their progress as far as language, intercultural communication, meta-cognitive and professional skills are concerned and identify the methods which have enabled this progress - improving their presentation skills using anecdotes - transferring to colleagues
What?	Learning anecdotes
How?	Each participant chooses from the different elements collected and brought back one item that he considers of interest for other students going on mobility in the future. This can have something to do with <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - what they have learned (knowledge) - how they have changed their view of the host country and their home country (know-how) - how they have changed due to this experience (existential skills)
Learning outcome?	Chosen anecdotes

Discussion

Participants discuss

- about what they have learned (knowledge)
- in how far they have changed their view of the host country (know-how)
- in how far they have changed due to this experience (existential skills)

Each participant chooses one anecdote to share with other students who intend to go on mobility in the future.
