3. Professional background / Parcours professionnel:

I graduated History and English Language and Literature at the Faculty of Philosophy at the University of Zagreb in 2002. I got my first teaching position while still a student, in 1995. I have been working as an English teacher for 15 years. During that period I have worked in primary and secondary schools, as well as language courses, and taught students from kindergarten to adult age and various level of knowledge. In the past two years I have been actively involved in mobility programmes in education, since the

beginning of Croatian participation in Lifelong Learning Programme of the European Union.

I have been involved in LLP for two years. I had heard about Comenius before, but I knew Croatia could not participate then.

My first experience in mobility was a Comenius Contact Seminar in Oulu, Finland, in September 2009. It was a real revelation to me. All the things I had thought about, a European network of teachers, possibilities of international cooperation in education, things I imagined would be useful, had already been functioning throughout Europe, through Comenius partnerships and eTwinning.

There a met a group of teachers and during the next four months we developed a project idea which we applied as a Comenius Multilateral Partnership. However, the project was approved in all countries except Croatia where it was put on a stand-by list due to limited funds in the Croatian National Agency.

In Oulu I also met a school manager from a primary school in Sibiu, Romania. That contract proved useful in my next international project. I organized an English teacher exchange with that school in April 2010. For one week, I was in their school in Romania, teaching about Croatia, and an English teacher from Romania came to my school. It proved an excellent experience, for both students, who had the opportunity to be taught by someone from a different culture, learn about life in another European country, and teachers, who met a new colleague and found out a lot about living and working in a different educational system, as well as practice their English in everyday situations. The funding for the project implementation presented a problem, but I managed to secure it from the local and the regional government. I described the experience in an article I published in the school magazine. The next experience was eTwinning. I was introduced to the portal by the teachers at the Contact Seminar. Soon I joined a project, later I started some more projects where I involved not only my pupils, but also my coworkers. In May 2010 I was promoted to the status of eTwinning Ambassador for Croatia at a Professional Development Workshop in Villasimius, in Sardinia. There I met some more teachers, found out about the advantages of eTwinning and in September started a new eTwinning project.

Unfortunately, I was taken ill then, had to go on sick leave and had to put all my activities on hold. I returned to work in January, resumed my work on eTwinning projects, I am in the process of developing a project idea for Comenius Bilateral Partnership with the school in Sibiu, Romania. I have been trying to organize another teacher exchange, this time with Hungary and involving not only English, but also History and Maths teachers from my school, who have shown interest in it, but so far I have not been able to find adequate partners. Throughout the past two years I have been active in the teachers community as well. I have given lectures and workshops on Comenius and eTwinning on school level, at teachers' assemblies, on county, regional and national level. It is something I enjoy, I believe I have experience to share and I have been getting positive feedback from the participants of my workshops. It is the work I intend to do in the future and share my future experiences in mobility.

First, I will share the experience with my pupils, in English classes; then with my coworkers, in teachers' assembly; at the county and regional level, at County and Regional English Teachers' Assemblies; and, if given a chance, at national level, at HUPE (Croatian English Teachers' Association) Conference, or some other event organized by the Ministry of Education or Croatian National Agency.

I also expect to make valuable contacts with teachers from Europe and start an eTwinning, ACES or Comenius project in the future, involving not only pupils from my school, but colleagues as well.
